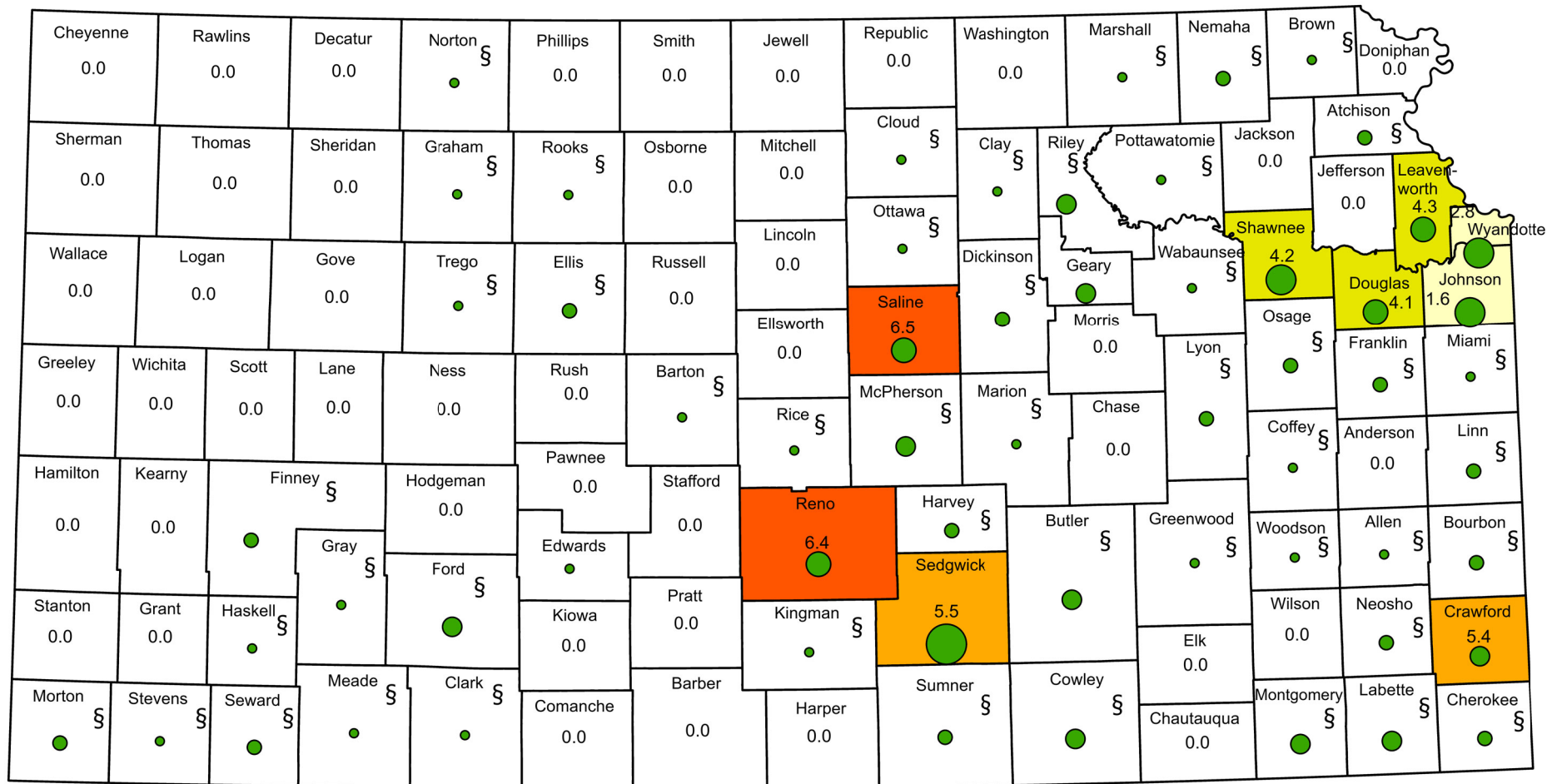


# Neonatal Abstinence Syndrome (NAS) Case Counts and Rates\* by County of Residence, Kansas, 2016-2020
