Cross-Cutting: Holistic Care Coordination Activities

Objective 7.4: Increase the number of MCH-affiliated programs providing holistic care coordination through cross-system collaboration by three through 2025.

Activities During Federal Fiscal Year 2023

Holistic Care Coordination (HCC) Implementation Toolkit: Title V continued to promote HCC across primary care settings. The HCC website was established to support ongoing awareness and transparency of this project. The website houses a toolkit to help those interested in HCC get started. Expansion of this work was halted in late FY23 due to a vacancy on the Title V team but is intended to continue when positions are filled.

Plans for Federal Fiscal Year 2025

Holistic Care Coordination Planning: Due to changing in staffing during FY24, the Holistic Care Coordination work of Kansas Title V had been put on hold. With the expansion of the Health Consultant Unit to include a Child Health Consultant and a Family Systems Consultant and the new universal NPM of Medical Home for children with and without SHCN, the two consultants and Title V leadership will work in FY25 to re-evaluate this work and if and how it should be integrated into future medical home efforts. Additionally, the results of the Title V Needs Assessment will be used to further help the Title V team determine what the best next steps are for holistic care coordination.
